It is great pleasure to announce that 4TH International Seminar on Biocosmology. This year, the Seminar is held in **Chung-Ang University, Seoul, Korea, on December 14th-15th, 2012**. This meeting is conducted by the *Biocosmological Association* and *Chung-Ang University* and is entitled as:

Biocosmology and the Individual Development

Our general point of view is that the natural world is essentially universal. This is the natural sciences' truth at least since the discovery of the structure of DNA by James Watson and Francis Crick. Still, however, the aim itself of introducing universalizing explorations into the practical activities is beyond the interests of global scientific and humanities community.

Significantly, we treat Biocosmology as a form of neo-Aristotelism, thus recognizing *Bio*-universality for all the levels of the organization of life: biological, ecological, anthropological, sociocultural, and global evolutionary or cosmist.

A substantial point is that Biocosmology remarkably matches Asian cosmological thinking that refers to Confucianism, Buddhism, Shintoism, Hinduism and Islam. The Biocosmology supports their basic idea about the original symmetry between the whole Universe and each living subject.

The proposed Biocosmological meeting in Seoul exactly realizes an attempt to move forward to develop the goals of universalizing cognition in the present and future cultural activity.
